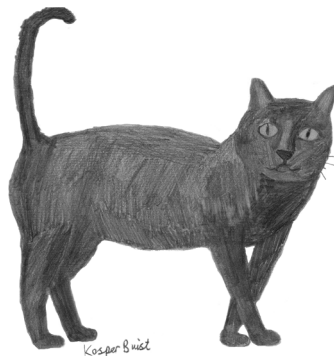


## The Liquorice Stories
